This means that half (5250) of all the athletes who will compete are female ("Paris 2024 - Games wide open," 2024). This is a monumental achievement, given that in the 1900 Paris Olympics, only 22 females competed. Evidently, this year's Olympics will be open and inclusive. The slogan Games Wide Open also embodies people's inclusivity. First, it welcomes teams from across the world (Izard, 2023). Any sovereign state with a National Olympic Committee (NOC) is welcome to participate. This is a positive aspect because it ensures that inclusivity is achieved. People across diverse racial and ethnic groups are included in the world's biggest sporting event. This fosters global unity and peace.

Thirdly, the Paris Olympics will include all people with unique abilities. The Paralympic Games, which shares the same slogan with the Olympic Games, will also be the biggest in living memory. It will have 549 sporting events and be as inclusive as the Olympics. Like the Olympics, it will also be open to everyone. More than 3 million tickets are available for anyone who wants to watch the events (Estanguet, 2022). Finally, the transparency and openness that has been demonstrated in the organization of both the Olympic and Paralympic Games is a testament to the slogan of Games Wide Open. More than 500,000 people have been given a sneak peek into these events, and more than 40,000 have been invited to volunteer to help organize the two events.
